RULES OF CONDUCT (please read carefully)

- 2. Food vendors must provide a copy of their food licenses
- 3. All items should be removed from the area no later than 4:00 p.m. on Saturday December 2 ,2023. Before leaving, booth space should be left in the same condition as it was upon arrival. Trash and other debris may not be left behind. If a booth area is not cleaned properly vendor could risk attendance at future events held at the location. Trash cans are provided by venue.
- 4. Only bring items/product that was disclosed to the fair committee PRIOR to the event Final booth number is permanent space. You will not be allowed to be moved as this will result in several vendors being relocated to please one person. No early packing, tearing down even 10 minutes before end time is shown as being disrespectful to event staff, shoppers and other vendors, and will not be tolerated. Vendors should have booth open during all show hours. Those who violate this policy may not be allowed attendance at future events and removed from Vendors Page. 9. Vendors may not physically alter the area in any manner, including putting any nails or objects into walls or floors. And keep all set up equipment and product within the designated boundaries to avoid interference with other booths.

Vendors that do not abide by the Rules of Conduct may be asked to leave the event and risk not being able to attend future events.
